## **BISHOP BARAGA CATHOLIC SCHOOL ARCHERY TOURNAMENT**

CHEBOYGAN, MI:      On March 5, 2011, the Bishop Baraga Catholic School Archery Club held its annual tournament. To prepare for the tournament, club members met weekly after school since October to receive instruction in basic archery skills through the National Archery in the Schools Program. Adult instructors were Jerry Canell, David Neph, and Ray Reiter.

Tournament day activities started at 10:00 a.m. Participants consisted of students from ages 9 to 13, competing in age groups of 9-10 and 11-13. Each participant shot three ends - three rounds of five arrows each - at archery targets from 10 meters. Upon completion of the 10-meter shooting, the shooting line was moved to 15 meters. Again, all participants shot three ends. Completion of the 15-meter shooting concluded the competition.

When the scores were tallied, Zach Gildner took first place in the 9-10 age group. Garrett Hudson finished second and Zavin Goodrich was third. Ricky Kydd was the winner in the 11-13 group. Emma Brisson took second and James Reiter finished third.

A highlight of the day was a raffle for a handmade recurve bow, quiver, and arrows made by Wayne Doyle. Kim Jacobson of Cheboygan won the beautiful prize.
