BISHOP BARAGA CATHOLIC SCHOOL ANNOUNCES SUMMER DAY CAMP

CHEBOYGAN, MI: Bishop Baraga Catholic School will host two week-long summer day camps for all Cheboygan area students currently in Kindergarten through 6th grade. Students can enroll for either one or both weeks. The first session - from August 1st through the 5th - has a theme of Camping around the World. Mystery-CSI Baraga is the theme of the second session from August 8th through the 12th. Sessions run from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily. Cost is \$125 per week per student. games in a Christian environment. Lunch and snacks will be provided daily to the campers.
