Baraga-isms!

*An ever-expanding list of words that you'll run into as a new Baraga parent.
This list should only be used as a quick reference - the school handbook
or, better yet, a Parent Mentor will be able to give you more depth.*

Color Day - Students have option of wearing non-uniform dress clothes.

Popcorn Day - Students have option of pre-purchasing bag(s) of popcorn.
These days fall on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month.

Dress Down Day - Students have option of wearing non-uniform casual clothes, including jeans and sweatshirts. Students are usually asked to bring in a dollar for a service project or food item for the local food pantry in order to participate.

The Gala - The big school fundraiser (usually near the end of Sept) spearheaded by the Baraga Boosters. A fancy, dress up date night for parents, including dinner, live & silent auctions, open bar and dancing.

St. Patrick's Day Party - The Baraga Home & School sponsored fund raising party in March featuring appetizers, drinks, auctions and dancing. Casual night out!

Fall Fling - A fun evening at the school where parents, students and teachers get together and play! Snacks are served. All the activities are set up by the teachers as a way to just say "thank you"!

Spring Program - Showcase event featuring the students and staff at the Cheboygan Opera House. Just get there early to get a good seat.

Knights of Columbus (K of C) Hall - Where the Gala & St. Pat's Party takes place. Take Straits Highway (aka Main) South or out of town; just before M-33 on the left.

Pickup/Drop-off - You can park and walk in to get your student, or you can form a car line in front of the building (staying out of the bus path) and a school monitor will radio in to someone on the inside, who will then send out your student. It may take a few weeks for the monitor (usually Mrs. Watkins, the Brave) to recognize your car. This is especially helpful if it's -20 degrees out and you have young ones bundled up in the car ... not that it ever gets that cold in Cheboygan.
