Then you can pick up your 'yes' card in-store at the Customer Service desk. During the registration process, you will be able to link our school code to your card. Our school code is 87600.

Here's how to participate:

4. Show your “Fun Funds” card whenever you shop!


### **Target's "Take Charge of Education" Program**

Target has a series of charge cards called REDcards. These include the Target Visa Credit Card, Target Credit Card, Target Check Card or an eligible Target Business Card. When a customer uses a REDcard to pay for their purchase, Target donates 1% of the purchase price to the customer's designated school. Once a year, all the donations are added up and a "no-strings-attached" check is sent to the school.

Cut out the UPC code from any Spartan brand product and return it to the collection box at school. No registration or paperwork is necessary.

**Spartan UPC = 2 cents/each**
