

How to Register

OPEN ENROLLMENT

We are accepting registrations now for the current school year.

Bishop Baraga Catholic School is dedicated to ensuring a quality education for all families willing to enter into a partnership to develop each child to his or her fullest spiritual and academic potential. By enrolling in Bishop Baraga School, students and their parents or guardians accept and agree to abide by the requirements, policies, and regulations of Bishop Baraga Catholic School and the Diocese of Gaylord. Bishop Baraga Catholic School is open to students whose needs can be met by our school staff without jeopardizing the education of other students.

Bishop Baraga Catholic School does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, national origin, age (in accordance with the law), or special needs condition (if, with reasonable accommodation on the part of the school, the person could be accommodated), in compliance with all requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Education and Federal Regulations. Our school will also not deny admission to students because of a demonstrated financial need.

1. The primary factor considered for families enrolling their children in Bishop Baraga Catholic School will be the presence of other siblings within the school. These families will be allowed to register first during In-school Registration. Registration fees are nonrefundable.
2. Bishop Baraga uses an open registration format. This means that you are welcome to register your child at any time. During the school year, registration packets are available at the school office. During the summer, you can pick up registration information at the St. Mary's/St. Charles Parish Office.
3. Bishop Baraga Preschool is a separate program from the elementary school and operates on a first-come, first-served basis during both the In-School and Open Registration periods. Registration forms are numbered for this purpose. The registration fee is nonrefundable.
4. Each family is required to pay a \$25.00 Technology fee, due at the time of registration for K-6.
5. Nonrefundable registration fees are \$35.00 per child, due at the time of registration.
6. Children being registered for kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 1st and must have the following at the time of registration:
 - Official State Birth Certificate with Seal (available from County Clerk's Office)
 - Baptismal Certificate (if applicable)
 - Up-to-date Immunization Record
 - Kindergarten Age Waiver
