BISHOP BARAGA PLAYGROUND RULES

- 1. Be respectful of others, their personal space, and belongings.
- 2. Settle differences peacefully and invite those without other friends to play.
- 3. Students will not play rough on the playground, no grabbing, hitting, pushing or using offensive, unchristian, vocabulary.
- 4. Students will leave rocks, bark, sticks and other dangerous items alone.
- 5. Sand and sand toys are to be kept in the sandbox.
- 6. Any equipment brought out by a student will be returned by the student.
- 7. Students will play only on designated playground areas.
- 8. Students will respect playground equipment, use it properly and safely. Climbing on top of play equipment is unsafe and not allowed.
- 9. Students will dress appropriately in winter clothing during colder months. Points will be given after the first offense.
- 10. Students will stay away from puddles and mud, the berm and hill. Students may use the track.
- 11. Alert the aide or volunteer if you need to re-enter the building before the end of recess. Students may get a drink at the end of their recess.
- 12.When recess is over, students will stop what they are doing and line up quickly. When all are lined up and ready to enter, the aide or volunteer will direct students grade by grade to quietly enter the building.
 - 13. Students will stop what they are doing and listen carefully when they hear a whistle.
 - 14. Lock down drills will be completed twice yearly outdoors. Continuous ringing of the bell or two sharp whistles will alert students to exit the playground to the designated safe place.
