

Dear Parents,

Nub's Nob School Program 2022 will once again partner with Bishop Baraga School to provide a fun and cost effective way to keep our kids active in the winter months.

We are excited to announce that this year we will continue to allow K-7 to participate in SKI CLUB! Keeping in mind ski club is a privilege for our students. Any discipline issues at school or at Nub's Nob may result in your child losing that privilege for the season. If students are for any reason ineligible due to their grades or discipline issues at school, they will not be allowed to attend ski/snowboard club until they are again eligible.

Ski/Snowboarding forms are available in the foyer and **MUST be returned by Tuesday each week with payment, there will be no exceptions!** Ski forms will be in a folder on the bulletin board in the foyer of the school. You can always make a copy and save one at home for each week, or pick one up from the office. Paperwork must be turned in to Nub's for an accurate count of students/parents! Checks should be made out to Jennifer Budzinski.

Lift Ticket - \$15.00

Chaperone lift tickets – Regular rates apply. **IF** there are **MORE** children than chaperones requesting lift tickets then the discounted rate is permissible.

Ski / Snowboard Rental Package - \$10.00 (includes Helmet)

Helmets (mandatory) - \$5.00

Ski / Snowboard Lesson - \$10.00

- Lessons should be determined upon the skier's skill level. This is up to the discretion of the parent/guardian.
- Nub's does not offer lessons in the school program for K-2 students, therefore these students **MUST** already be active skiers from previous seasons or currently learning with a parent or guardian.

Mrs. Budzinski will need each skier's information when turning in this permission form: height, weight, age, shoe size, skier type (beginner, intermediate, advanced). This information will be kept on file at Nub's Nob so when we send the weekly list of student's names they will have the sizes ready for our skiers.

- Nub's Nob requires a signed Liability Release Form for every student. That form is attached to this letter and must be returned by **November 29th, 2021** as well as the bottom portion of this letter.
- Parents must sign up in the office to drive/chaperone by Tuesday night! All drivers must carry \$500,000 liability coverage.

## SKIERS/SNOWBOARDERS Ration

For grades 5th-7th you do NOT have to be a skier to drive/chaperone. MUST use the "buddy system" while skiing on the hills and check in with their assigned chaperone throughout the night.

K – 4<sup>th</sup> grade students MUST be with a skiing/snowboarding chaperone at ALL times. Ratio 1 Chaperone : 2 Children.

It is your responsibility to make sure your child has either a buddy and/or a chaperone to ski with during our Friday night visits. K-4 must have a skiing chaperone at all times, 5<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> must use the "buddy system" and stick with each other at ALL times.

Please consider this **VOLUNTEER SERVICE** so that our young people may take advantage of this super opportunity! We rely solely on parent drivers!!

Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough drivers, we will not be able to have ski club on that particular Friday.

It is recommended that your child packs a snack and/or has money to buy something at the resort. There are many options available. Often times there are parents on the Facebook group who are organizing a food table, this cuts down on your cost. If you are interested please let the other parents know via Facebook.

- Ski / Snowboard Club will meet on Friday's in the Nub's Nob rental area upon arrival. You must pick up your lift ticket at this time from Mrs. Budzinski by 6:00pm.
- Ski lessons are promptly at 6:00 right outside the rental area so you MUST be prompt. At the end of the evening you must return all equipment by 9:30

Ski/Snowboard club may be cancelled due to weather conditions and will be communicated as early as possible. The decision will be made by 1:00pm the day of and you will be notified via school email, and/or remind text.

**\*\*If ski club is cancelled, you MUST submit a new form for the following week!**

It is required that your child(ren) are dressed properly so they can be warm! Gloves, snow pants, winter coats and hats are required. Goggles and facemasks are recommended but not required.
