What is Raiseright?

Raiseright is a method to save money toward tuition costs. Rebates may only be used for tuition costs.

RaiseRight will donate 90% of any rebates you earn through your RaiseRight gift card purchases to a school family you designate. RaiseRight will make donations for tuition three times a year: August 15, January 15 and May 15.

Families can enroll themselves by going online to www.shopwithscrip.com. Call the school office for the school code to enroll. RaiseRight orders are due by Monday at 8:30 am and cards will arrive by Friday morning at the very latest. If school is out on Monday, the order will go in on Tuesday. If ordering with an order form, place your order with payment in the drop box or deliver it to the school office by Monday 8:30 a.m. You can leave your order and payment at the school office anytime. Print your order form and bring it to school with payment.

How does it work?

Before grocery shopping, filling up with gas, eating out, buying clothing, purchasing gifts for wedding, showers, birthdays or anniversaries plan ahead and place your order on Monday am so that you will have the gift cards by Friday (at the latest) for those places you intended purchasing for any of the above items. A percentage of every card purchased goes to the school with 90% going to the family designated for tuition when the transaction occurred.

Your family and friends may also use these cards, which quickly increases the amount adding up towards your student's tuition costs!

Where can I use RaiseRigt cards?

There are approximately between 850-900 businesses that are a part of this program. Some of the local stores that are involved in this program are: Family Fare, Walmarat, Dunham's, Shell, Speedway, Holiday, Mulligan's Dairy Queen, Melody's Lane, Creation Station, Harbor Outlet, Advance Auto, AutoZone and Rivertown Do It Center. Many out of town restaurants, stores in the malls, hotels, motels, coffee shops, gift shops, etc., or a hunting trip at Cabelas, or Lands End. You can use them when doing a project or need a new appliance at your home from Lowe's or Home Depot. There are too many ways to mention here!
